The Holford Defoe Collection

This collection of 155 volumes and over 500 titles represents a significant portion of the work of Daniel Defoe. Defoe, one of the most prolific of 18th-century authors, has had over 400 books, pamphlets, and periodical contributions accredited to his pen. This collection, while it includes editions of his novels *Robinson Crusoe*, *Moll Flanders*, and *Roxana*, is primarily concerned with Defoe's political writings and his contemporaries' responses to them, including works by Samuel Johnson, John Trenchard, Henry Sacheverell, Benjamin Hoadley, Edmund Curll, Eliza Haywood, John Oldmixon, and, of course, "Anonymous."

The collection was formed by Robert Stayner Holford (1808-1892), one of the original members of the Burlington Fine Arts Club and one of 19th-century England's greatest collectors of books and art. Holford acquired part of his Defoe collection from George John Warren Vernon, 5th Baron Vernon (1803-1866); these volumes bear the Vernon arms in gilt on their covers. Dr. A.S.W. Rosenbach purchased the collection at auction in 1928 after the death of R.S. Holford's son, Sir George Holford (Sotheby, 27 March 1928, lots 254-340).

The English Literature Collection contains other Defoe material, including the William S. Lloyd *Robinson Crusoe* collection, and other books from the Holford Library are part of the Rosenbach collections. For more detailed information, consult the Rosenbach card catalog.
